Education and welfare provision for pupils with statements and pupils for whom English is an additional language

JAGS is committed to providing the best possible education and care for all its pupils.

Currently we have no pupils with statements of special educational need (SEN). However, when we have had such pupils in the past we have worked closely with the local authority providing the statement and the parents in order to ensure that the pupil's needs have been met as far as reasonably possible. We will make all reasonable adjustments to the curriculum and facilities to meet the needs of any such pupils in the future.

All JAGS pupils are tested in English language as part of our entry procedures and they are normally expected to have reached a good level of fluency before being admitted to the school. However, we have some 50 home languages spoken by our pupils and we offer additional support in English to those who are in need of it. In the Senior School we have an EAL specialist within the English department.
