Controlled Assessment & Coursework Deadlines

Coursework or controlled assessment forms a part of many GCSE courses. It usually takes place during lesson time.

Classical Greek, Japanese, Latin, Mathematics, R.S and Russian do not have a coursework or controlled assessment component. The Sciences are assessed through practical tasks (ISAs) and written examinations.

The majority of subjects have written examinations forming part, or whole of the GCSE.
