



Sixth Form Scholarships

Scholarships are available in Music and Art; candidates choosing these subjects for A level and who wish to apply for a scholarship should submit an application at the time of registration, or by the registration deadline of 15 October 2022. Once you have registered your daughter for a place at JAGS and created an admissions account online you will be able to view and complete the scholarship forms.

Assessment for the Art scholarship is on Saturday 28 January 2023 whilst the Music assessments will be held on Friday 25 November 2022.

Candidates who apply will be invited to attend, subject to the results of the Sixth Form entrance examination. These Scholarships are usually valued at £1,000 per annum, to be deducted from the school fees. In addition, there is often a supplement for those awarded a Music Scholarship to cover the annual tuition fees for one or two musical instruments, to be determined by the Music department.

Additionally, applicants are also eligible to be considered for Academic scholarships. There is no need to apply for these: these are awarded post GCSE results to pupils who have received in excess of at 10 GCSEs at grade 8 or 9, although cannot be guaranteed and are at the discretion of the Headmistress. Sixth Form Academic scholarships are valued at £1,000 per annum, to be deducted from school fees.
