for 11+ Entry for September 2023

Our 11+ Assessments will comprise

- Attendance at a Welcome Morning at some point in the Autumn term. Welcome Mornings will consist of:
 - A one on one interview with a senior staff member at JAGS
 - A short creative writing task
 - An interactive group task
- The ISEB Common Pre-test (to include tests in Maths, English, Verbal and Non-Verbal Reasoning), to be sat:
 - Either at a candidate's current school, between early November 2022 and 10 January 2023, OR
 - At JAGS on Thursday, 5 January 2023
 - Or at another Senior School to which they are applying.
- Please register with ISEB directly in September and check to see if your school is named as a hosting school.

Scholarship Applications

Our deadline for submission of scholarship applications is 30 November and application forms are available online via your Admissions account (once created) by September. References are required only for Music and Sports scholarship applications and referee email addresses should be provided at the time of application. Please note that not all candidates who apply will be called for a scholarship assessment. All candidates who apply for a scholarship will be informed as to whether or not they have been selected for assessment by Tuesday, 17 January.

11+ Sports Scholarships – initial assessments on Tuesday 24 January and a 2nd round on Tuesday 31 January.

11+ Art Scholarships – the Art Scholarship examination will be held on Saturday, 28 January and photos of recent art work for preliminary selection should be submitted by Monday, 9 January. Further details regarding criteria for photos and how to submit them will be sent to Art scholarship applicants on receipt of an application.

11+ Music Scholarships – auditions will be held on Wednesday, 1 February.

Please note that all 11+ candidates are automatically eligible to be considered for an Academic Scholarship; there is no need to apply. Those performing strongest in the entrance assessments will be invited to an Academic Scholarship assessment session on Wednesday, 25 January.

Bursaries

If you are intending to apply for a means-tested James Allen's Bursary, you will find information about our bursaries on our Admissions pages, and our deadline for submission is 15 November. Bursary forms will be available in due course. Please note that supporting documentation is required.

We will be requesting references directly from the Head of the candidate's current school. These reports will be treated as confidential and will not be discussed with candidates or their parents.

Offers

All results letters will be sent out by email on Thursday, 9 February. Some of these letters may be for places on a short waiting list. Information about precise positions on the waiting list is not given. We are unable to predict whether or not we are likely to be able to offer from the waiting list.

Post Offer Morning

All those holding offers will be invited to attend an onsite taster event on Thursday, 23 February. This will be subject to Governmental regulations in light of Covid-19 at the time.

Acceptances

The school must receive written notice of acceptances by 12.00 noon on Monday, 6 March. If there is any reason why you cannot make a decision by this date, you should let the school know. If no reply has been received by this date and time it will be assumed that you do not wish to accept and the place may be reoffered.
