### For 16+ Entry in September 2027

#### Registration

Our Sixth Form Registration form opens online from **22 April 2026** for those applying for entry in September 2027 and closes on **19 October 2026**. This is a sixth month registration window and regretfully we cannot accept late applications.

#### Assessments

Our 16+ Assessments will comprise

- A Thinking Skills Paper
- A Critical Essay Paper
- A General Interview
- 2 x Subject-Specific Interviews

All offers are conditional upon candidates achieving the minimum GCSE entry requirements. More information regarding GCSE entry requirements can be found in the Sixth Form Prospectus on our website.

#### Scholarship Applications

Our deadline for submission of Art and Music scholarship applications is **Monday 19 October** and application forms are available online on our website from early September. References are required only for Music scholarship applications and referee contacts should be provided at the time of application. **YOU DO NOT NEED TO PROVIDE US WITH REFERENCES DIRECTLY; WE WILL SOURCE THESE.** Please note that not all candidates who apply will be called for a scholarship assessment.

**16+ Art Scholarships** – the Art Scholarship examination will be held on **Friday 22 January 2027** and photos of recent artwork for preliminary selection should be submitted by **Monday 4 January**. Further details regarding criteria for photos and how to submit them can be found in the Scholarship brochure on our website.

**16+ Music Scholarships** – date for auditions is to be confirmed.

**16+ Academic Scholarships** - please note that all 16+ candidates are automatically eligible to be considered for an **Academic Scholarship**; there is no need to apply. These Academic Scholarships are awarded on academic merit, based on GCSE results.

## Bursaries
